

# PUBLIC NOTIFICATION OF NOTICE OF REQUIREMENT FOR AN ALTERATION OF DESIGNATION

## WATER RESERVOIR – RUAKIWI ROAD

Hamilton City Council has received notice of a requirement for an alteration to a designation from Hamilton City Council – Capital Projects, and gives notice of its requirement for an alteration to designation (The Requirement).

### THE REQUIREMENT IS FOR:

The alteration of existing Designation A67 - Water Reservoir (Ruakiwi Road) within the Operative Hamilton City District Plan (ODP) is to extend the boundary of the designation and enable the construction, operation and maintenance of the Central City Reservoir Project, which includes two new 25 million litre reservoirs, a valve chamber, pipelines and ancillary infrastructure.

### THE SITE TO WHICH THE REQUIREMENT APPLIES IS AS FOLLOWS:

Northeastern part of the Hamilton Lake Domain Reserve above Lake Domain Drive, with direct frontage onto Ruakiwi Road.

(Physical address: 18A and 24 Ruakiwi Road, and 68 Pembroke Street.)

All submissions must include: name, postal address, email address, phone numbers, if you support or oppose with reasons, the recommendation or decision you seek and whether you wish to be heard and/or attend a hearing, and whether or not you are a trade competitor.

A person who is a trade competitor may only make a submission if that person is directly affected by an effect of the activity to which the requirement relates that—

- adversely affects the environment; and
- does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
